


# Unit-based → Behaviour based Data Capture

  - Unit ID's are missing or protected
  - Informed consent unavailable
  - Confidentiality statements questioned






### 2.1 Grouping






### 2.1 Grouping 2.2 Linkage

# Wrapping up and pointing forward

- Tables that are not planned, will not be produced.
- While digital sources are direct sources to behavioural data, surveys are a more direct source to attitudes.
- When id-lists are missing, group allocation needs to be based on nonpersonal characteristics and behavioural patterns
- Statistical adjustment may be necessary, quality assessments certainly
- Trusted Execution Environments needs to be trusted by those involved
