



# Crowd-Sourcing: Integrated Data Collection Systems Palestinian Statistical Business Register, Obstacles and Methodologies

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## Introduction

"Business Register" (BR) is considered as one of the most important examples of Integrating data from several sources, that contains different forms in terms of coverage and quality, this difference, due to the difference in registration methodologies and main purpose of registration of each source.

"Business Register" (BR) as a concept has two forms, "Administrative Business Register (ABR)" and "Statistical Business Register (SBR)"; the main difference between them is that the census records which serves statistical purposes, belong to SBR and not to ABR. Moreover, ABR is the starting point to build the SBR.

## SBR Objective

### Cost

Very low cost system compared to implementing a comprehensive census



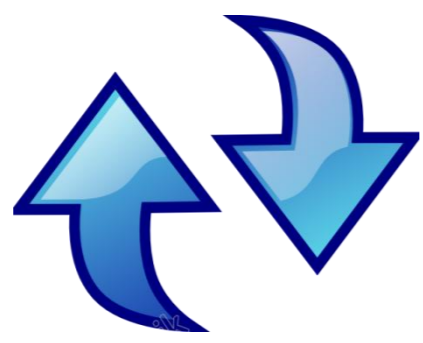
### Quality

High quality due to the interconnection of several sources compared to data quality from only one source



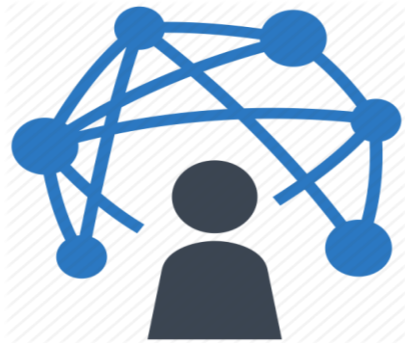
### Update

The Update of the system by partners is continuously compared to a census executed every 5 years



### Coverage

Broader coverage of institutions, benefiting from coverage of several sources and several methodologies in registration



## Life Cycle of SBR and Data Flow

### Data Collection

The files of data should be collected from each party, computerize the non-computerized ones, and keep them in the original and excel/csv format.



### Data Description

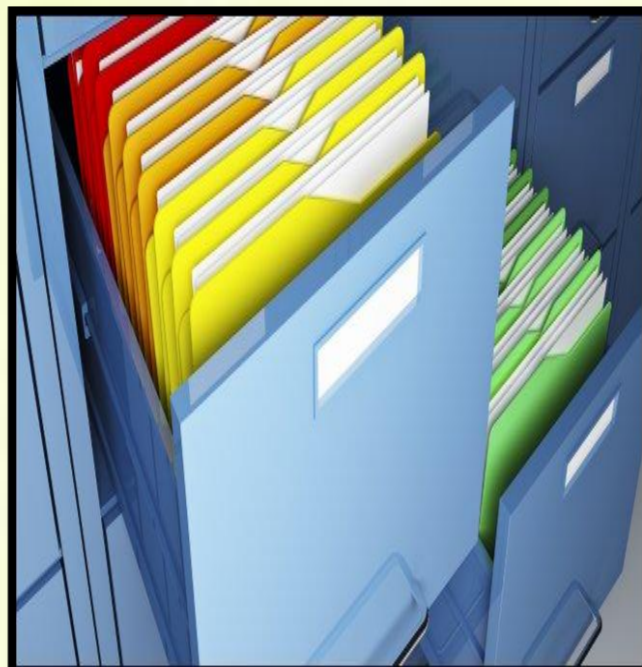
The data should be described in a special form to analyze the current situation, to facilitate the programming work in building the matching program and to study the problems of each file.

### Data Cleaning

A set of rules are implemented to be applied on different files to make the data more consistent as much as possible to improve the quality and coverage of matching.

### Data Matching

The matching process is based on comparing the matching variables together in a set of priorities in a certain score through Duke tool in JAVA.



### Manual Validation

Several variables are used to take the decision if the automatic matching is true or not, such as the ID, commercial name, owner name, phone numbers, activity, and the address.



### Values of the Variables

After the validation, the best value of each variable is chosen according to a set of priorities (depending on the quality of the files)

## General Description of SBR-V1

**V1** The BR-V1 covers enterprises and establishments (local units) in the West Bank that are registered in the partners files which intersect between at least two partners. Almost 40,000 establishments (to compare with the 100,000 establishments recorded in establishments Census 2017) are already included in first version.

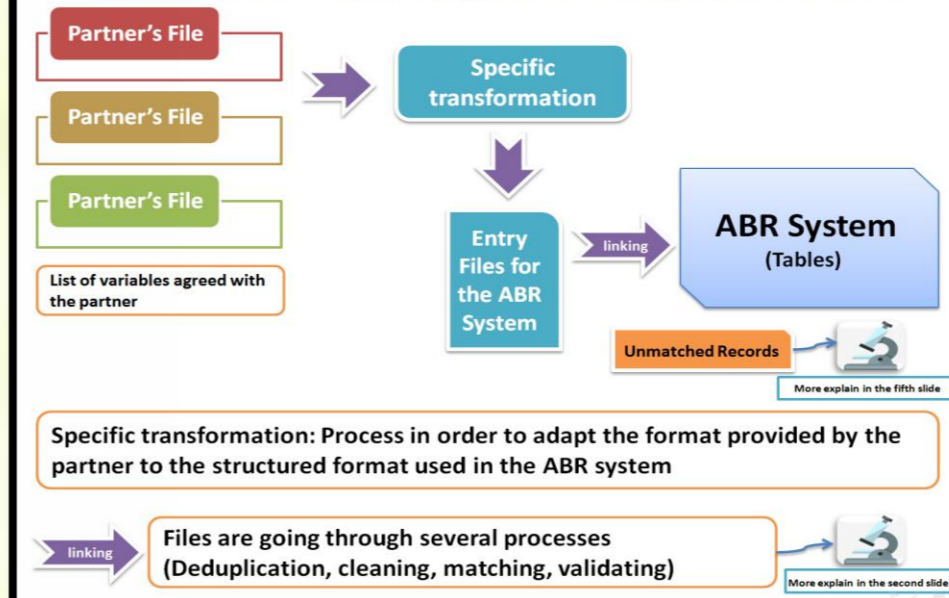

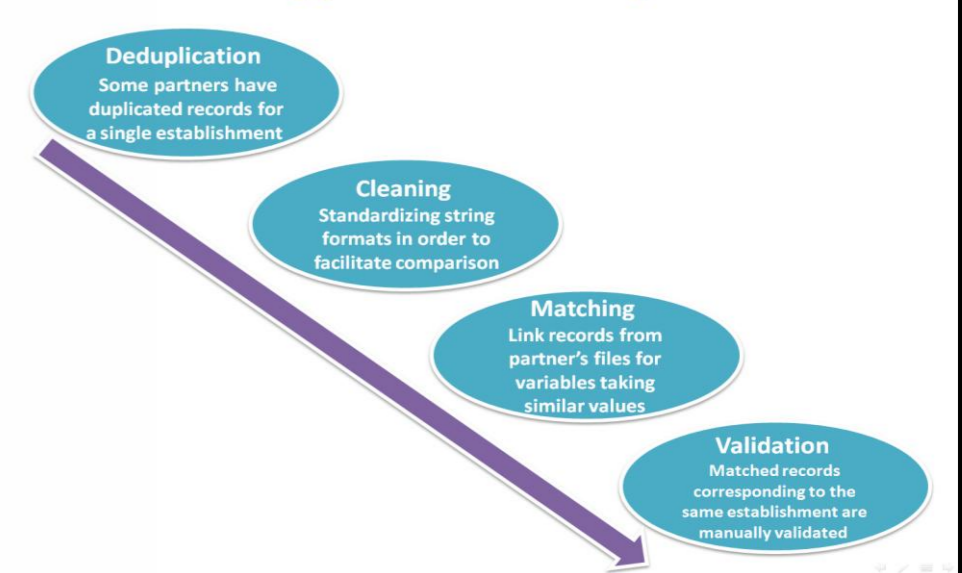

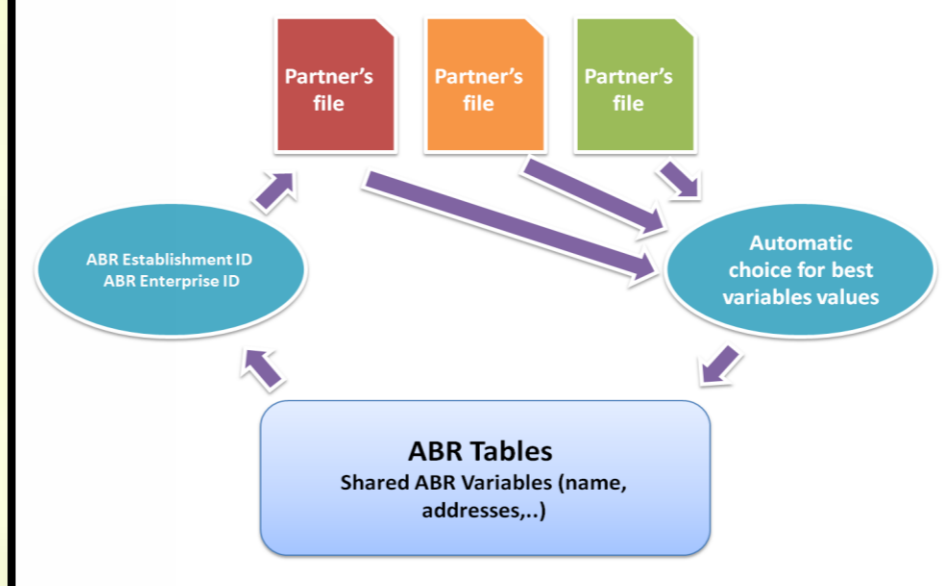
### Initial process for import of the partner's files



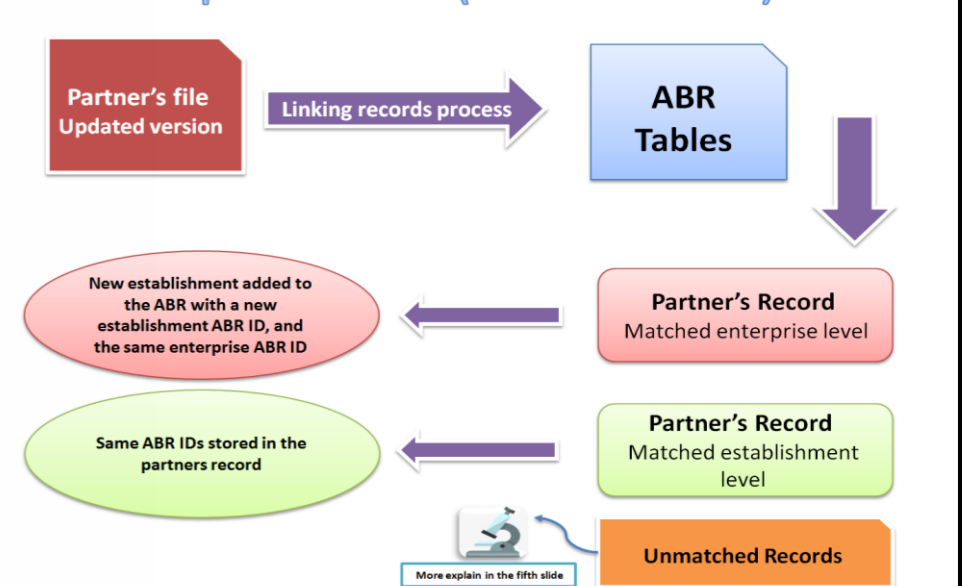
### Linking partner's records process



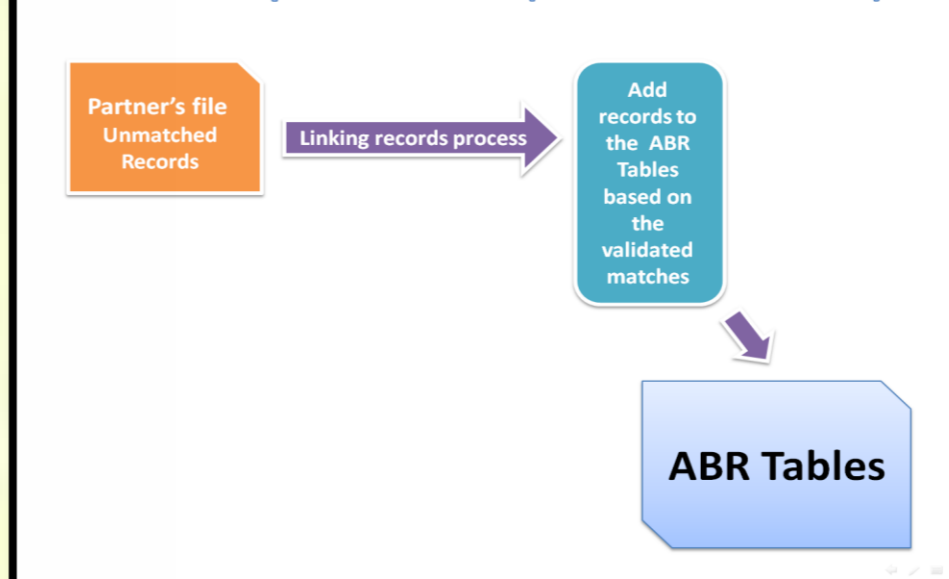
### Flow data into the ABR & Partner's feedback



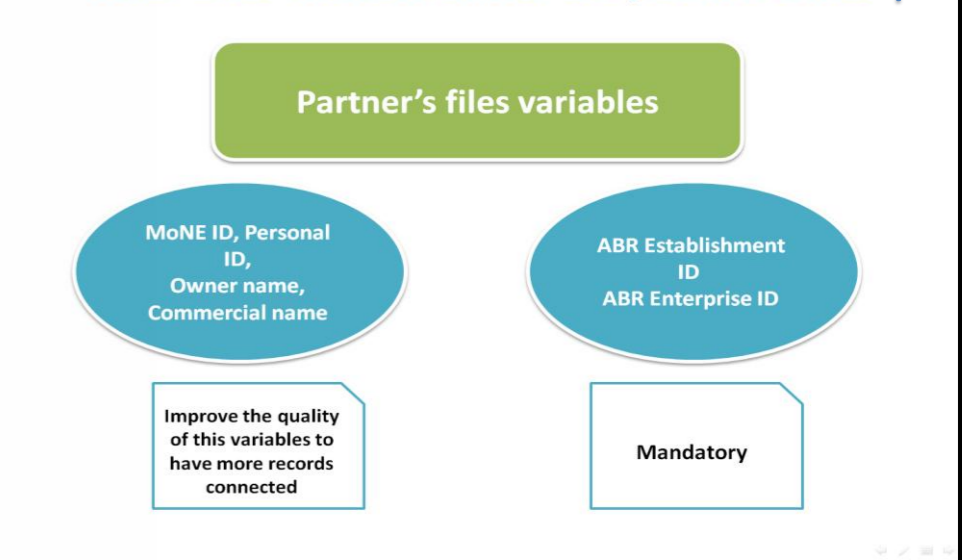
### Update Process (Matched Record)

## SBR System Basic Characteristics

No duplication of establishments or enterprises records

"ABR shared variables" that allow contacting economic units

Storage all the Data in efficient, reliable, and secured way

Connects the establishments registered to the enterprise they belong to

Sharing the database among partner in order to use it for updating its own register

## The Risks and Difficulties (Challenges)

Poorly the coverage of partner register on which the ABR coverage is based

Partner files do not record "matched" variables correctly, these variables is the most crucial information to create secure links

The duplication of the records in the data of the partners, one of the responsibilities of the ABR management team

The data collected by partners is poorly recorded, not updated, and not comprehensive

The partner does not provide sufficient information to have an effective process of determining the links between records

The follow-up of institutions to modernize their "active" statute, this follow-up should be undertaken by local administrations
